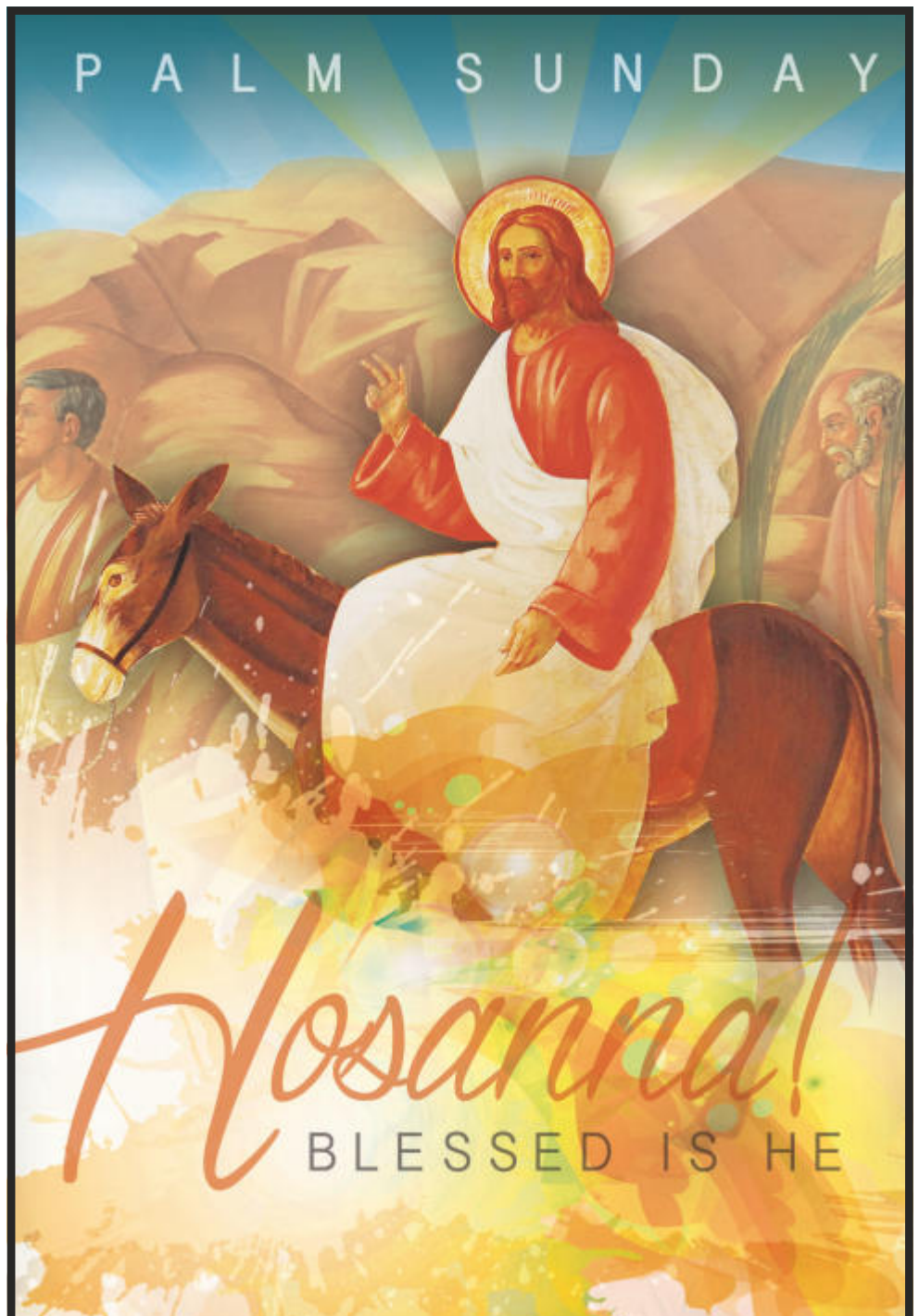

Folks every year we read, the Passion of our Lord Jesus Christ on Palm Sunday. We stand for 10 minutes and recall the events that led to the suffering, death and resurrection of Jesus—throughout Holy Week. We remember and read, so we don't forget. This is most important, especially in raising a family in the faith. It is important to teach your children and yourself the 'means' behind our Salvation.

How did it all come about? When did it happen? Who was there? These are very important questions we should know the answers to -everyone should know the answers to. As parents we should make sure our children know the reasons why we need salvation and how we've come about receiving it.

This Sunday take time to really put yourself into the Passion narrative. During holy week try and find that one detail in the passion story that you might not have heard before. Either way reflecting on Jesus' passion will create a sorrowful moment in you heart, which in turn will help you enter more deeply into the mysteries. Does it sadden you when you hear the words of the Passion story? Are you even moved? Look upon the cross this Sunday, and ask yourself. Do I really even know? What was it like for Him who died and suffered for us? Everyone should open their hearts to be moved this week. For it was through His wounds that we are all saved...
