



LENTEN OBVSERVANCES

- 1. Catholics who have celebrated their 14th birthday are to abstain from meat completely on all Fridays during Lent, Ash Wednesday, and Good Friday.
- 2. In addition to abstaining from meat, Catholics who have celebrated their 14th birthday, until their 59th birthday, are to fast on **Ash Wednesday** & **Good Friday**.
- 3. A recommended fast from the Church: 1 small meal in the morning, 1 meal at lunch & 1 small meal in the evening. The two small meals together should not equal the size of the regular meal.
- 4. When abstaining from foods or pleasures during Lent, always remember a spirit of detachment. It is in letting go of the things in the world, that we find peace, God and ourselves re-centered on Jesus Christ


