




Within the Word – Faith to walk on Water

Folks, in the period that follows the Sermon on the Mount, Jesus heals many and then calls his disciples to do the same. He teaches in parables, learns of the death of His cousin John, and then feeds more than five thousand men, using only five loaves of bread and two fish; not including their families. What a crazy scene...After hearing of the death of John the Baptist, Jesus seeks solitude and yet the people follow anyway. Evening approaches and Jesus sends his disciples toward the other side of the Galilee. He dismissed the crowd, and finally retires to pray; and apparently for many hours, because he didn't approach the disciples' (in their boat) until "the fourth watch," which is somewhere between 3 and 6 a.m. What a strange situation...They're all in the boat, Jesus is nowhere to be found. The disciples' see some figure out at sea, and imagine that it's a ghost. And common sense would follow, that no ordinary human could do such a thing, so they assume a spirit. Their cries of fear prompted Jesus' response, to be not afraid. Upon hearing Jesus' voice, Peter asks if he can join Him. Again, what a strange situation...

As he concentrated on Jesus, he walks on water. But we learn that when he focused on the wind and the waves, he starts to sink and drown. This is a great lesson for all of us in life. We too need to always keep our eye on the prize; whom is God, the Pearl of Great price, the greatest prize of them all. And as Jesus always does, He comes and saves Peter. After pulling him out from the waves, Jesus replies, "Oh you of little faith, why did you doubt?"

Friends, we must be sympathetic to Peter. We can all relate to his experience. Almost all of us, to some degree understand how hard it is to keep focus on Christ, especially when the world is trying to distract & throw many storms our way. Remember the devil loves to distract us from what's important...Some consider this a rebuke by Jesus. However, it was more likely a gentle encouragement for Peter to have more faith. After all, Peter was the only disciple who had enough faith to step out on the water in the first place!

What happened after stuns everyone. The wind, that had been hindering the disciples all night suddenly stops. Jesus was capable of not only walking on water but calming the wind and waves as well. not including their families. What a crazy scene...After hearing of the death of John the



Son of God. In this miracle, Jesus rescues Peter by showing his power over the elements, over the physical world itself. Friends, its true, that when you trust Jesus, you too can "walk on water." Jesus gives us the ability to accomplish the impossible. Weaving faith into our lives gives us the ability, to not only do the impossible but the phenomenal as well. Ask Christ for the faith of Peter, Jesus will respond to you, especially when we're in such need of His grace & mercy. Pray for the end of the pandemic, & use the rosary to do so. All it takes is a little faith. Have faith....you can walk on water even with a little.

To the Ladies Sodality, THANK YOU, Again!




