

What a wonderful time, during a horrible year to celebrate something new. Ever need a change of space? Or felt the need to "change it up?" Well, Advent for



er need a change of space? Or felt the need to "change it up?" Well, Advent for me is a great time to do that. It is a highly anticipated season, because I feel it's exactly what we require from time to time -to remember the coming of our King. The year is extra special as it is most needed, to help unify & heal families. We've just gone through a crazy election year, we're dealing with an ongoing pandemic, & folks from all over are feeling the side affects of these challenges. Now is the time to prepare for Christ's Advent. Now we must take the initiative & Pray.

On a personal note, I must share that I will no longer be working full-time at St. Mary's. I will continue to perform all my duties but on a smaller scale. My October accident left me with some serious injuries. Some of which I am not comfortable sharing. But I have the best doctors at the Madison and Tomah VA, along with my new physical therapist in the Dells. I also have been asked to take full medical leave, requested by both medical doctors & the diocese. As much as that would promote my recovery faster I simply can't leave our parish, my flock and all the families that need their priest. (most especially for weekend liturgies) So starting this coming Tuesday and moving into next spring, I will no longer offer public mass on Tuesday's. Tuesday will be a day of prayer and therapy for myself to heal. I have serious issues with my spine, back and wrists, and that's only half of it. I know this sounds extreme, but my accident was life changing.

I hope in the future to share more, but I'm still working on processing and coping with that trauma. I've allowed myself this time, so Wednesday-Sunday, I will be working 20-25 hours. This was the compromise I had with my primary care provider, doctors & diocese. This will be an adjustment for me & one that I hope no one will notice. I ask to be kind & patient with me, forgive me and pray. I promise to put 110% into my recovery, as to promote a quicker return. I am not a 'sit still' kind of guy, & to a fault

I don't always have the best, 'self-care' attitude regards to my self. (hence why everyone's telling me to take care of myself." So in the spirit of changing it up, I'm going to be 'taking it easy,' as best as I can to fully rehabilitate and recover. As good Ole St. Rita says, (while pointing a finger) "Your no good to anybody, if your Dead!" Yes, Rita, I hear you Loud & Clear...Also folks I ask that you pray the rosary for our many families, who are becoming infected with Covid. We have many. May God bless all of you in the Season of Advent! TY!!


