





Hello Everyone

I am Fr. Chinnappan from India, Diocese of Vellore the southern part of India. I am from a small village called Kariyandal, the total population of the village 5200 people out of which are 723 Catholic families. My father Mr. Pelavendran passed away in the year 2004 and my Mother Mrs. Annammal passed away in the year 2016. I have four elder brothers and one elder sister. My only sister is a Nun (A Woman Religious) working in the Sava Missionary of Sisters congregation



From 2010 -2012 I was placed as the Parish Priest of St. Lawrence Church, Kasthampbodi. There I started evening study centre for the poor students, that they can be given enough opportunity to learn and practice. During this time the Basic Christian communities of the parish were strengthened, with weekly prayer services and celebrating the Eucharistic in their respective Basic Christian communities. The new presbytery was also built at the same time. Believing that youth are the pillars of the Church I have done skill development program for the local youth.

From 2012 - 2017 I was given opportunity to be the Director of Diocesan youth commission and Director of commission for scheduled caste and Scheduled tribe. Animating the youth of the Diocese at different levels for developing their knowledge, skill and personality. Every year more than 1000 youth were placed for jobs in multinational companies. Annual retreats were done for more than 1500 catholic youth. Seminars for the students and married couples were conducted on specific topics to improve their life situation at a regular period of time.

From 2017 to 2021 I am placed as the Parish priest of Haffieldspet. A new tabernacle was installed in the church. Youth of the Parish have been animated to become effective leaders in the society and in the church. There was also animation for the married people to strengthen their married life. Faith renewal programs are being conducted at regular period. During that time the Stations of the cross are built. The Diocese has given me additional responsibility as the Secretary for the Prison ministry. Every Sunday I celebrate mass at 2 pm in central prison Vellore. Visiting the prison regularly for counseling the prisoners and giving them hope for the future. Then I came here to the Diocese of Lacrosse March 23, 2021.

So I hope this is helpful in getting to know Fr. Chinnappan. Perhaps many of you know me from the last few years at St. Patrick or being the Dean of the Tomah Deanery. The plan is for the two of us to work out a regular schedule for the liturgical celebrations at St. Mary. We are looking not only to the weekend but getting some Masses and confessions going during the week also. But I do ask your patience as setting certain things up takes more time than you would think. As we are going forward I will be handling administrative duties for St. Mary. Deacon Hale is happy to handle some of the meetings and liturgical events when able and the staff there has done a great job making sure day to day things happen. All of these arrangements are being put in place so that Fr. Clayton may focus on his full steady long term recovery. As anyone knows who has gone through a long illness the waiting and patience is the hardest. So in this month of May we ask Mary's intercession for us all.


Next Sunday we will acknowledge and honor our 8th grade and 12th grade graduates at the 9:00 am Mass.


