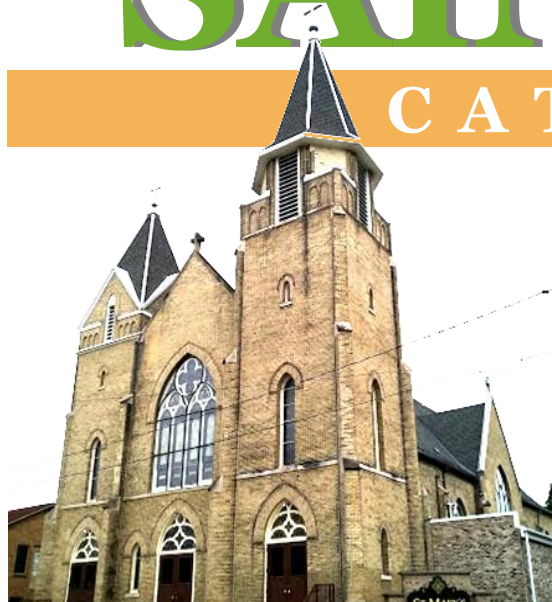

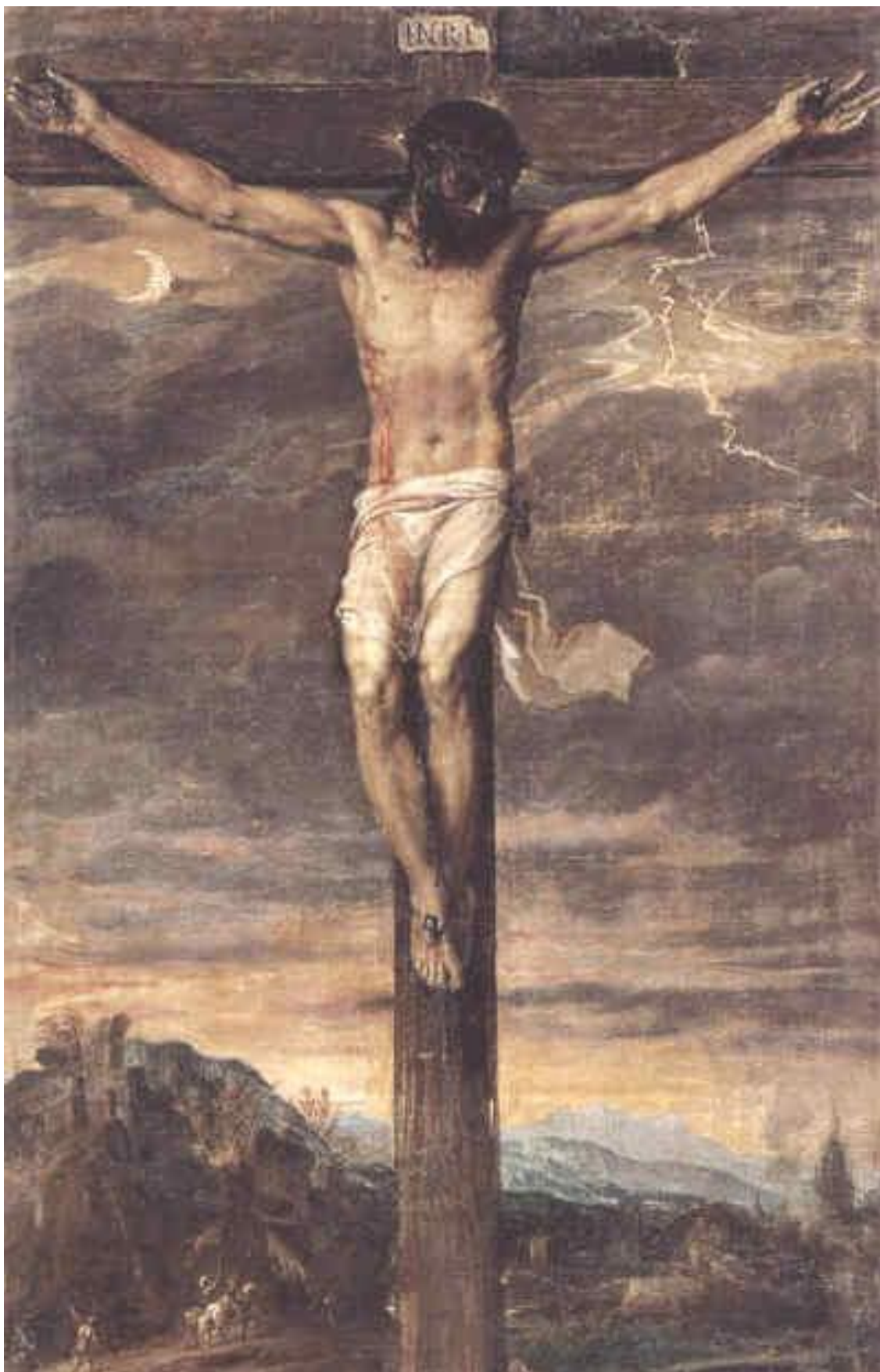

## A Note From Fr. John

Welcome to the official kick off of the “Inspired by the Spirit” capital campaign. We (St. Mary and St. Patrick parishes) are part of the pilot phase of this campaign.
