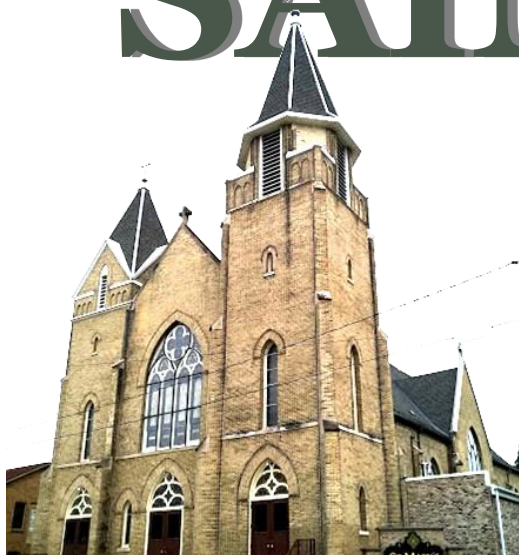

A Message from Fr. Cryton,

The Power and Joy of Being in the Family of God

THE TENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME calls us to reflect on the power and joy of being in the God's family. Family conveys a sense of belonging. To be in the family of God means to be accepted for who we are: loved, cherished, celebrated, and fully forgiven. Let's reflect a few thoughts from Meg Bucher.

What Is the Family of God According to the Bible?

"A Christian is one who has been adopted by God - brought into the family of God, all by the Son of God. And this changes everything," (D.A. Carson for *Desiring God*). This family of brothers and sisters in Christ are more deeply connected to us than any other relationships, even our earthly families! We share a spiritual unity through our common Father, God! As God's family, we are His arms and legs on this earth. From hugs and words of comfort to feeding hungry bellies, we operate by the love of God to spread the love of God, to all His people. God choose us to be in His family

Is the Church the Same Thing as the Family of God?

The family of God is the church, but the church is not confined to a building. *"In him you are also being built together into a dwelling place for God by the Spirit"* (Ephesians 2:22). The church meets to worship God and pray to Him together. We gather to support and encourage each other, because the work of the Lord, though joyful, is difficult. It takes everyone's talents and collective contributions to accomplish the purposes of God. **What Is the Purpose of God's Family?**

God created earth, us, and everything in it. However, we are warned against congealing with the patterns of this world. The purpose of God's family is transformation, a slow and steady sanctification to conform our hearts to Christ, as we were created, designed, and purposed. We change daily as we follow Christ. As the local church movement for Christ grows, it isn't just individuals who change, but communities. The purpose of God's family is to move and go on account of the Gospel, not just preaching the word, but acting in love, reflecting the love of our Savior Jesus.

How You Can Invite Others into the Family of God?

We lead others to God by example and invitation. When God is our first priority, our lives reflect His love. Our families and homes exude the love and grace of our Heavenly Father. Inviting others into the Family of God requires us to lean in and listen for His lead. This isn't the way the word behaves. It's not how our social media feeds read. So, when people witness this type of behavior, which flows not from anything we do, but from Christ in us, their hearts naturally incline to ask where our hope comes from.

Change to Stipends effective July 1st, 2024

For 30 years the suggested donations for Masses, funerals, marriages has remained the same throughout the dioceses of Wisconsin. The Bishops of Wisconsin gathered recently and decreed that stipends should be adjusted to reflect the current time and to account for inflation.

The new suggested stipends are as follows:

Mass Stipends: \$20

Funerals: \$75

Marriages: \$100

Quinceaneras: \$100

These new suggested amounts take effect with events that take place on or after July 1, 2024. They do not apply retroactively to those who have already paid the appropriate amount for an upcoming event (**even one that takes place after July 1, 2024**) The new suggested stipend amounts will be applied to all new requests we receive for events that occur on or after July 1, 2024.

As always, if someone is not able to offer the stipend, the parish is always happy to provide the sacrament or service with no fee.

Mother of our Creator, pray for us! As Mother of our Creator, Mary wishes to remove even the shadow of every, even the slightest doubt, that through the use of the word "God" in her title as Mother of God, we wish to express the real, eternal Son of God, Him whom the Holy Gospel calls the Creator.

Mother of Good Counsel, pray for us! The gift of counsel relies on the capacity for a wise discernment, especially in difficult and decisive moments, so that as the next step, we may choose what is appropriate in accord with this. This is why the Church places on Mary's lips the words of Sacred Scripture: "Mine are counsel and advice to the wise." (Prov 8:14)
