

Next weekend, August 10th & 11th, we'll welcome Fr. Joseph Okine-Quartey from the Accra Archdiocese/St. Paul Catholic Seminary in Ghana for Mission Co-op weekend. There will be a second collection. Dear Parishioners,

Mission Co-Op 2024

I am writing to share with you a pressing need and an opportunity to support the future of our Church. Our seminary (St. Paul's Catholic Major Seminary, Accra-Ghana) is experiencing a surge in vocations. With 82 candidates seeking admission to our Propaedeutic program, our total population is rising to 236, compared to 204 last year. We have had to house most seminarians in pairs because of inadequate accommodations.

However, the nature of the Propaedeutic level of formation demands that seminarians be housed in a conducive environment for prayer, silence, and discernment. To accommodate the 82 prospective seminarians, we must complete this first-year residence hall, which has stalled and requires urgent attention.

We must finish constructing the remaining 16 rooms to accommodate at least 72 out of the 82 prospective seminarians, a chapel, sickbay, and library, and provide essential furniture and beds. The total cost for this project is approximately \$60,000. We have locally raised \$15,000 in cash and pledges to set the project in motion. Since we still need funds to accomplish this, we turn to you in the spirit of missionary fraternity for your assistance.

We humbly appeal to your generosity to help us meet this need. Your support will directly impact the formation of our future priests, who will serve our communities and the universal Church and spread God's love.

Any contribution, big or small, will bring us closer to our goal. Please consider donating to this noble cause. Together, let us build a stronghold for our seminarians to grow in faith, knowledge, and service.

May God bless you for your usual kindness and support.
