## **Day of Mercy**

- Pray the Rosary (Glorious Mystery)

### Prayer of St. Faustina to be Merciful

Help me, O Lord, that my eyes may be merciful, so that I may never suspect or judge from appearances, but look for what is beautiful in my neighbors' souls and come to their rescue.

Help me, O Lord, that my ears may be merciful, so that I may give heed to my neighbors' needs and not be indifferent to their pains and meanings.

Help me, O Lord, that my tongue may be merciful, so that I should never speak negatively of my neighbor, but have a word of comfort and forgiveness for all.

Help me, O Lord, that my hands may be merciful and filled with good deeds, so that I may do only good to my neighbors and take upon myself the most difficult and toilsome tasks.

Help me, O Lord, that my feet may be merciful, so that I may hurry to assist my neighbor, overcoming my own fatigue and weariness (...) Help me, O Lord, that my heart may be merciful so that I myself may feel all the sufferings of my neighbor. (...)

Review your roles with God and what is happening in these roles right now. Ask God what He thinks needs to change in each of your roles. And be faithful to what He has entrusted to you.

## Prayer of St. Francis of Assisi

Lord, make me an instrument of your peace: where there is hatred, let me sow love; where there is injury, pardon; where there is doubt, faith; where there is despair, hope; where there is darkness, light; where there is sadness, joy.

O divine Master, grant that I may not so much seek to be consoled as to console, to be understood as to understand, to be loved as to love. For it is in giving that we receive, it is in pardoning that we are pardoned, and it is in dying that we are born to eternal life.

## **Friday**

## Day of discerning God's Plan

Ask God for spiritual eyes to see and ears to listen to His perfect and pleasing will.

- Pray the Divine Mercy Chaplet
- 1. Make the Sign of the Cross
- 2. (Repeat three times)
- O Blood and Water, which gushed forth from the Heart of Jesus as a fount of mercy for us, I trust in You!
- 3. Our Father,
- 4. Hail Mary,
- 5. The Apostles' Creed
- 6. The Eternal Father

Eternal Father, I offer You the Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity of Your Dearly Beloved Son, Our Lord, Jesus Christ, in atonement for our sins and those of the whole world.

- 7. On the 10 Small Beads of Each Decade For the sake of His sorrowful Passion, have mercy on us and on the whole world.
- 8. Repeat for the remaining decades Saying the "Eternal Father
- 9. Conclude with Holy God (Repeat three times)

Holy God, Holy Mighty One, Holy Immortal One, have mercy on us and on the whole world.
